

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

APPOINTMENT OF DELEGATES TO CONVENTION TO PROPOSE AMENDMENT TO THE U. S. CONSTITUTION

This Appointment of Delegates issues for the purpose of authorizing delegates to represent the Legislature of the State of _____ at a Convention organized to propose amendment to the U.S. Constitution.

WHEREAS various states have applied to the U.S. Congress for a Convention called to consider proposing an amendment to the U.S. Constitution; and

WHEREAS this Legislature, acting for the State of _____, intends to commission and authorize delegates as its representatives at such Convention:

BE IT RESOLVED that _____, _____, and _____, are hereby commissioned and authorized as delegates of this Legislature with power to represent this Legislature specifically, and the State of _____ generally, at said Convention.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, unless the Convention orders otherwise, the delegates shall vote on all business as a unit, the majority of the delegates determining this State's vote.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Legislature orders and constrains the delegates to propose, to entertain, or to consider no other business except term limits for members of Congress, exclusively, resulting in a proposed amendment the same as, or similar to:

ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT XXVIII

Section 1. No person shall be elected to the Senate more than twice, and no Senator who has served for more than two years of a term to which some other person was elected Senator shall be elected to the Senate more than once.

Section 2. No person shall be elected to the House of Representatives more than four times, and no Representative who has served for more than one year of a term to which some other

person was elected Representative shall be elected to the House more than three times.

Section 3. No person shall be a Member of Congress for more than fourteen years in total.

Section 4. This article shall apply to Members of Congress when this article is ratified but shall not prevent any person who may be a Member of Congress during the term within which this article becomes operative from continuing to serve the remainder of such term.

Section 5. This article shall be inoperative unless it shall have been ratified as an amendment to the Constitution by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States within seven years from the date of its submission to the States by the Congress.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that authority is reserved to rescind and to terminate the authority of any delegate for any reason at any time, and that the delegates authorization otherwise remains in effect until the Convention shall conclude or until 2 years from the date of this Resolution, at which time this Resolution shall expire.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no provision of this Application is severable from the rest.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the _____ of the _____ (Senate) and the _____ of the _____ (House) of this state shall jointly certify copies of this Authorization and deliver the same to the Delegates named herein.
