

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

RATIFICATION OF ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT XXVIII to the CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

Relating to the proposed Article of Amendment XXVIII to the Constitution of the United States of America which establishes term limits for members of Congress.

WHEREAS a constitutional convention proposed an Article of Amendment XXVIII to the Constitution of the United States of America, which, when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several states, shall be valid to all intents and purposes, and which Amendment states:

ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT XXVIII

Section 1. No person shall be elected to the Senate more than twice, and no Senator who has served for more than two years of a term to which some other person was elected Senator shall be elected to the Senate more than once.

Section 2. No person shall be elected to the House of Representatives more than four times, and no Representative who has served for more than one year of a term to which some other person was elected Representative shall be elected to the House more than three times.

Section 3. No person shall be a Member of Congress for more than fourteen years total.

Section 4. This article shall apply to Members of Congress when this article is ratified but shall not prevent any person who may be a Member of Congress during the term within which this article becomes operative from continuing to serve the remainder of such term.

Section 5. This article shall be inoperative unless it shall have been ratified as an amendment to the Constitution by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several States within seven years from the date of its submission to the States by the Congress.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the _____ of the State of _____, with the concurrence of the _____, hereby ratifies to all intents and purposes the foregoing Article of Amendment XXVIII, as proposed by previous constitutional convention, to become a part of the Constitution of the United States of America.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the _____ of the _____ (Senate) and the _____ of the _____ (House of Representatives) of this state shall jointly certify copies of this Application and send the same to the United States National Archivist, to the President and Secretary of the United States Senate, and to the Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, Washington, D.C.
